



Key Instant Recall Facts Year 1 – Spring 1

I know number bonds for each number to 10

By the end of this half term, the children should know the following facts. The aim is for them to recall these facts **instantly**.

$0 + 10 = 10$	$2 + 8 = 10$	$4 + 6 = 10$
$10 + 0 = 10$	$8 + 2 = 10$	$6 + 4 = 10$
$10 - 10 = 0$	$10 - 8 = 2$	$10 - 6 = 4$
$10 - 0 = 10$	$10 - 2 = 8$	$10 - 4 = 6$
$1 + 9 = 10$	$3 + 7 = 10$	$5 + 5 = 10$
$9 + 1 = 10$	$7 + 3 = 10$	$10 - 5 = 5$
$10 - 9 = 1$	$10 - 7 = 3$	
$10 - 1 = 9$	$10 - 3 = 7$	

Key Vocabulary

What is 7 **add** 3?

What is 8 **plus** 2?

What is 10 **take away** 5?

What is 1 **less** than 10?

Your child should be able to answer these questions in any order including missing number questions,

e.g $6 + \square = 10$ or $10 - 3 = \square$ or $\square + 3 = 10$

Top Tips!
