Top Tips!

The secret to success is practising **little** and **often**. Use time wisely. Can you practise these KIRFs while walking to school or during a car journey? You do not need to practise them all at once; perhaps you could have a fact of the day? If you would like more ideas, please speak to your child's teacher.

Talk about time – Discuss what time things happen. When does your child wake up? What time do they eat breakfast?

Make opportunities to look at the time - Make sure that you have an analogue clock visible in your house or that your child wears a watch with hands. You could give your child some responsibility for watching the clock.
