One and nine make ten
Two and eight make ten

Four and six make ten
Five and five make ten

Seven and three make ten
Six and four make ten

Top Tips!

The secret to success is practising **little** and **often**. Use time wisely. Can you practise these KIRFs while walking to school or during a car journey? You do not need to practise them all at once; perhaps you could have a fact of the day? If you would like more ideas, please speak to your child's teacher.

Use practical resources -

- Using items around the house to find different ways of making 10, e.g two blue Lego bricks and eight red Lego bricks. Two and eight make ten.
- Making up stories with items around the home, e.g there are 4 cars in the car park and 6 more cars arrive, how many cars altogether? Four and six make ten.
- Asking questions during daily routines, e.g you have 5 chips on your plate and I have 5 chips on my plate, how many chips altogether? Five and five make ten.
