<u>Use practical resources</u> -

- Using items around the house, find methods of counting accurately, eg. moving each object as it is counted. (We say 'move it to prove it!' in class) You could use sweets, stones, leaves etc
- Looking for numbers up to 20 around the home and when you are out and about.
- Count objects around the home and then write the correct numeral to match the quantity counted. Repeat with other numbers. Discuss which number is the greater/lesser or is more/less than the other. How do you know?
