School Uniform

Thank you to everyone for ensuring the children have returned to school dressed smartly and in the correct uniform.

Please ensure that all uniform items are named.

Please can we remind you that all headbands and ribbons should be in school colours only and must be small in size. Hair longer than shoulder length must be tied back in a pony tail or similar. Small gold or silver stud ear rings ONLY to be worn. No necklaces or bracelets to be worn. Girls school trousers should not be tight legging styles. School rucksacks must be small in size. Trainers and boots are not acceptable footwear. Black shoes only please. PE shorts should not be cycling shorts or skorts

Attendance & Punctuality

Please make every effort to get your child to school each day and on time – it makes so much difference to their learning and future achievements.

The Government have also made changes to the rulings on taking children out of school in term times. With this in mind please see our Attendance Policy on the school's website. Holidays will not be authorised and will be sent to the authority. This may mean you will be fined.

No Smoking Policy

Lancashire County Council schools are all no smoking zones. This includes E cigarettes. Please do not smoke in the school grounds. Thank you

Asthma

If your child is asthmatic please ensure a spare inhaler is in school and you have completed the asthma plan that is on the website.

Nut Allergies

We have a number of children and staff in school with nut allergies. Could I please ask that products containing nuts are not put in lunch boxes or bags. Thank you.



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Car Parking

We have had a number of 'near misses' where parents have reversed into the school gateways as others are walking past and where parents have refused to give way to each other almost causing an accident. Please be mindful of others and ensure cars are parked and driven safely on the roads around school. Please also be mindful of the local residents and do not park across their driveways etc. Cars should not drive up Alice Street. This is a cul de sac and cars pulling up at the top are causing issues for people who are walking to school. The school car park is for staff only and must not be used by parents who are dropping off or picking up.

Dogs on School Premises

Please can we remind you that <u>dogs are not allowed on</u> <u>school premises</u> due to health & safety. This includes dogs being carried inside coats.

Please do not tie your dog up on school property (inside the entrances to school or just outside the entrances. We have a number of children who are scared of dogs and are becoming increasingly anxious when they have to walk past them at the school gates.

For Lancashire resident families who will require a primary or secondary school place in September 2023 the means of application is via Lancashire's online system at:

This went live on 1 September 2023. It is quick and easy to use and offers an e-mail receipt for all submitted applications. Please ensure that you hit the "submit" button when you are ready to send in your completed online application.

The closing dates for applications are:

31 October 2023 - Secondary

15 January 2024 - Primary

You must apply even if you already have siblings at your preferred school
