School Uniform

Thank you to everyone for ensuring the children have returned to school dressed smartly and in the correct uniform.

Please ensure that all uniform items are named.

Please can we remind you that all headbands and ribbons should be in school colours only and must be small in size. Hair longer than shoulder length must be tied back in a pony tail or similar. Small gold or silver stud ear rings ONLY to be worn. No necklaces or bracelets to be worn. Girls school trousers should not be tight legging styles. School rucksacks must be small in size.

Trainers and boots are not acceptable footwear. Black shoes only please. PE shorts should not be cycling shorts or skorts

Attendance & Punctuality
