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Car Parking

We have had a number of 'near misses' where parents have reversed into the school gateways as others are walking past and where parents have refused to give way to each other almost causing an accident. Please be mindful of others and ensure cars are parked and driven safely on the roads around school. Please also be mindful of the local residents and do not park across their driveways etc. <u>Cars should not drive up Alice Street</u>. This is a cul de sac and cars pulling up at the top are causing issues for people who are walking to school. The school car park is for staff only and must not be used by parents who are dropping off or picking up.
