Mathematics



Place Value - know 2 digit and 3 digit names and properties.

Addition & Subtraction - be able to add and subtract 2 digit from 2 digit numbers such as $27 + 34 =$

To be able to use more formal methods such as column addition and subtraction methods to add 2 and 3 digit numbers.

Length & Perimeter - know the names of 2D shapes. Be able to accurately measure in cm's & mm's the sides of polygons. Calculate the areas of simple shapes.

Statistics & Data - to use pictograms to answer a range of questions. Collect data and put into a pictogram.

KIRFS - To know number bonds to 10 and then apply to 20.

To know 2, 5 and 10 times tables and be able to instantly recall them.
