## Science

### Living things and their habitats

During this unit of work, the children will explore and compare the differences between things that are living, dead and things that have never been alive.

They will identify that most living things live in habitats to which they are suited and describe how different habitats provide for the basic needs of different animals and plant, and also how they depend on each other.



## R.E

This half term the children will explore the story of Christmas from the perspective that it was good news then and now. As a class we will discuss how good news is delivered and passed on. We will support our learning with the Christmas Nativity.
